A public and personal profession of the Faith for adult believers in Jesus Christ is a hallmark of our Anglican tradition. **Confirmation by a bishop** is the way Anglicans express this profession of faith in a liturgical context. Whether baptized as an infant or as an adult, confirmation allows the believer to confirm the promises made in their baptism. In the early church, the Apostles prayed for and laid their hands on those who had already been baptized (Acts 8:14-17; 19:6; 2 Timothy 1:6-7).

At the direction of the Bishop, and after public reaffirmation of their baptismal promises, those having made adult professions of faith in other Christian traditions (including those confirmed in other traditions such as TEC, RC, and Lutheran) are *received* into the Anglican Church with prayer and the laying on of hands by a bishop.

Confirmed believers who are already Church members (including those received from other traditions, those returning to active Christian discipleship after lapse, and those experiencing a renewal of Christian commitment or significant life transition) may also *reaffirm* their faith in Christ and his Church with prayer and the laying on of hands by a bishop.
