

Ecosystem for Church Planting

Church planting initiatives within the Anglican Diocese of Pittsburgh will include five qualities that contribute to a healthy ecosystem for church establishment and growth.

- 1. A model/strategy for identifying a geographic region best suited for a church plant.
- 2. A process to assemble a critical mass/core team of gifted, spiritually mature lay leaders committed to giving their time/talent/money to the church plant initiative.
- 3. A model (pipeline) for identifying, vetting, and sending out appropriately gifted church planting pastor(s).
- 4. A financial plan/structure to support both the operating fund of church plants and compensation for the church plant pastors.
- 5. A team of peers/mentors/coaches to support and encourage the church planting pastor.

All the above can fit into one of four possible models for church planting:

- 1. Mother church model
- 2. Minister church model
- 3. Diocese-driven model
- 4. Organic gathering model
